Friday November 24th Reserve this date for a “Sapphire and Somethin’ Fishy” evening. More details to come !!

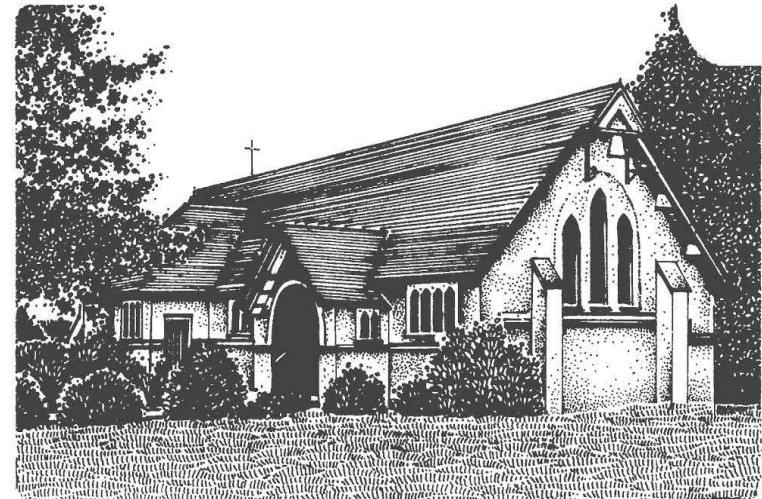
