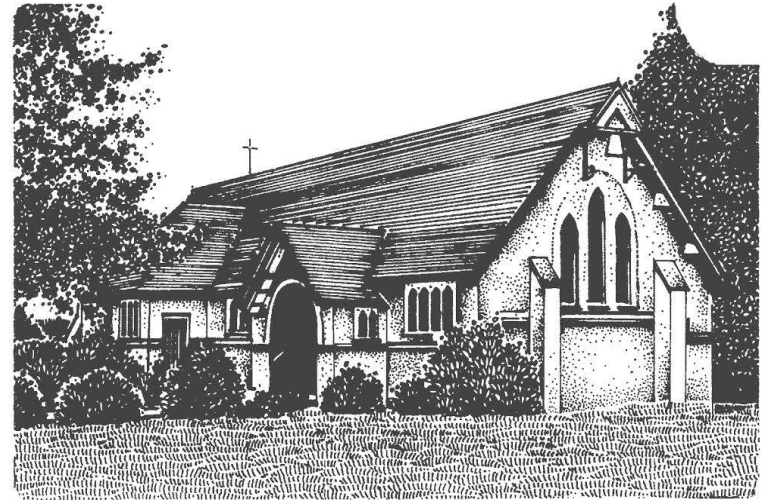

Corvid-19: Following advice given by the Diocese, we are taking the following actions:

Catering: We are cancelling the serving of teas and coffees etc. following all our services, and also at our Lent talks. There will also be no lunch after the APCM meeting on Sunday 29 March 2020.
